

This Privacy Statement applies to c3intelligence.com (“Web Site”) and services owned and operated by C3 Intelligence. Please carefully read our privacy policy to understand how we will treat the information you provide while visiting this Web Site and our service. It also describes the choices available to you regarding the use of, your access to, and how to update and correct your personal information. This policy may change from time to time. Please check the policy each time you use our Web Site for the most current information.

The use of information collected through our service shall be limited to the purpose of providing the service for which the Client has engaged C3 Intelligence.

C3 Intelligence participates in the EU/U.S. Privacy Shield Program for the transfer of personal data from the European Union and participating European Economic Area countries to the United States and has certified its compliance with the Privacy Shield Principles to the Department of Commerce. Collection and Use of Information

Tracking Technologies

We, and our partners, affiliates, or analytics and service providers, may employ tracking technologies such as cookies, beacons, scripts, and tags to analyze trends, to administer the Web Site, to track users’ movements around the Web Site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole.

When you visit this Web Site, we may collect general Internet data, including your domain name, the web page from which you entered our Web Site, which of our web pages you visited, and how long you spend on each page. To collect this information, when you visit our Web Site, a “cookie” may be set on your computer. Cookies contain information that allows our web servers to recognize you whenever you visit. We utilize cookies to record session information, passwords, and the profile of subscribed clients at a site in order to provide better service when visitors return to our Web Site. We use the information we collect to study how this Web Site is used, so that we may improve and enhance your experience on our Web Site. We also use persistent cookies. A persistent cookie remains on your computer after you close your browser or turn off your computer.

Third parties with whom we partner to provide certain features on our Web Site or to display advertising based on your web browsing activity, use Local Storage (HTML5) to store content information and preferences. Various browsers may offer their own management tools for removing HTML5.

Information Sharing

We will share your personal information with third parties only in the ways that are described in this privacy policy. We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

We may provide your personal information to companies that provide services to help us with our business activities such as criminal searches and employment verification. These companies are authorized to use your personal information only as necessary to provide these services to us.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- as required by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process
- when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request,
- if C3 Intelligence is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, you will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on our Web Site of any change in ownership or uses of your personal information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your personal information,
- to any other third party with your prior consent to do so

User Access and Choice

If your personal information changes, or if you no longer desire our newsletters or similar marketing services, you may correct, update, amend or delete/remove it by making the change on our member information page or by contacting us by email, telephone or postal mail at the contact information listed below. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to guard the PI you provide to us. Our products and/or services online are transmitted through a secured socket layer (SSL) transmission. Further, we have security protocols and measures in place to protect the PI we maintain about you from unauthorized access or alteration. These measures include internal and external firewalls, physical security and technological security measures, and encryption of certain information (including login credentials). No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. Personal Information Disclosure: United States or Overseas

All personal information will be transmitted and stored in a secure manner in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Links to 3rd Party Sites

Information Related to Data Collected through C3 Intelligence's Services

C3 Intelligence collects information under the direction of its Clients, and has no direct relationship with the individuals whose personal data it processes.

Choice

We collect information for our Clients, if you are a customer of one of our Clients and would no longer like to be contacted by one of our Clients that use our service, please contact the Client that you interact with directly.

Service Provider, Sub-Processors/Onward Transfer

C3 Intelligence may transfer personal information to companies that help us provide our service. Transfers to subsequent third parties are covered by the provisions in this Policy regarding notice and choice and the service agreements with our Clients.

Access to Data Controlled by our Clients

C3 Intelligence has no direct relationship with the individuals whose personal data it processes. An individual who seeks access, or who seeks to correct, amend, or delete inaccurate data should direct his query to the C3 Intelligence's Client (the data controller). If the Client requests C3 Intelligence to remove the data related to our marketing services and/or newsletters, we will respond to their request within 30 business days.

Data Retention

C3 Intelligence will retain personal data we process on behalf of our Clients for as long as needed to provide services to our Client. C3 Intelligence will retain and use this personal information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

Data Processing Contracts

- When personal data is transferred from the EU to the United States only for processing purposes, a contract will be required, regardless of participation by the processor in the Privacy Shield.
- Data controllers in the European Union are always required to enter into a contract when a transfer for mere processing is made, whether the processing operation is carried out inside or outside the EU, and whether or not the processor participates in the Privacy Shield. The purpose of the contract is to make sure that the processor:
 - 1. acts only on instructions from the controller;
 - 2. provides appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction or accidental loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure or access, and understands whether onward transfer is allowed; and
 - 3. taking into account the nature of the processing, assists the controller in responding to individuals exercising their rights under the Principles.
- Because adequate protection is provided by Privacy Shield participants, contracts with Privacy Shield participants for mere processing do not require prior authorization (or such authorization will be granted automatically by the EU Member States), as would be required for contracts with recipients not participating in the Privacy Shield or otherwise not providing adequate protection.

b. Transfers within a Controlled Group of Corporations or Entities

- When personal information is transferred between two controllers within a controlled group of corporations or entities, a contract is not always required under the Accountability for Onward Transfer Principle. Data controllers within a controlled group of corporations or entities may base such transfers on other instruments, such as EU Binding Corporate Rules or other intra-group instruments (e.g., compliance and control programs), ensuring the continuity of protection of personal information under the Principles. In case of such transfers, the Privacy Shield organization remains responsible for compliance with the Principles.

c. Transfers between Controllers

- For transfers between controllers, the recipient controller need not be a Privacy Shield organization or have an independent recourse mechanism. The Privacy Shield organization must enter into a contract with the recipient third-party controller that provides for the same level of protection as is available under the Privacy Shield, not including the requirement that the third party controller be a Privacy Shield organization or have an independent recourse mechanism, provided it makes available an equivalent mechanism.
